Rules:

- competition rules of the Czech Wushu Federation (EWUF)
- one participant can compete in maximum 4 categories (1× in each category)
- referee groups A and B (judging system), in modern wushu in junior and adults categories
referee group C
- competitive area of 8 × 14 m, the surface of Czech wushu federation carpet
- time limits:
 - › for traditional events:
 - 8 years and under: 20 seconds
 - 9-11 years: 30 seconds
 - cadets (12-14 years): 40 seconds
 - juniors + adults: 50 seconds
 - › for taiji quan:
 - bare hands: 3-4 minutes
 - weapons: 2-3 minutes
 - › modern wushu events:
 - 8 years and under: 16 forms
 - 9-11 years: 32 forms
 - cadets: 1st set of IWUF compulsory routines
 - juniors: 1st, 2nd, 3rd set of IWUF compulsory routines or self-made routines
 - adults: 3rd set of IWUF compulsory routines or self-made routines

General Rules:

competition rules comply to Czech Wushu Federation (in accordance with EWUF).

other events 150 CZK / 6 EUR

senior category (18 years and older, including)
first event 400 CZK / 16 EUR
other events 200 CZK / 8 EUR
